I understand I am assuming all risks inherent with any and all activities that I am participating in. Whether known or unknown, and that by signing this document I am giving up my right to sue Hershey School of Dance whether caused by the negligence of said person or entities.

Dancer/Parent Code of Conduct:

- Display a positive attitude and disciplined behavior to ensure a rewarding and productive dance class.
- Maintain honesty and integrity.
- Demonstrate respect for faculty and staff at all times. We expect all students to follow the directions of their teacher during the class. Questions and concerns may be discussed with the teacher after class in a respectful manner. If the teacher cannot meet after class, an appointment can be set up. If disrespect is shown to a staff member, the student may be asked to leave.
- Respect others. No bullying, gossip or isolation of other students.
- Respect your equipment: Dress appropriately (see dress code policy in brochure). Do not wear your dance shoes outside and do not wear your outside shoes to class. Get enough rest and eat a balanced meal before or after class.
- Arrive on time for class to avoid disruption to other students. It is recommended that students arrive at the studio 5 minutes before the start of class to allow time to prepare for class and warm up.
- Refrain from using inappropriate language. The use of inappropriate language will not be tolerated.
- Possession of drugs and/or alcohol policy: Any student found using drugs or consuming or under the influence of alcohol (including providing drugs or alcohol to another student) will be asked to leave HSD and will not be permitted to return.
- HSD reserves the right to ask any student or parent to leave the school for inappropriate behavior.
- Demonstrate respect for faculty and staff at all times. If disrespect is shown to a staff member, the family may be asked to leave HSD.
- Drop off and pick up student(s) on time. Hershey School of Dance is **NOT** responsible for children outside of the studio. Please be respectful of the staff's time.
- Do not leave children unattended at the studio. Your children and their conduct is your responsibility. If you bring additional children to wait while class is in session, bring something for them to sit and do quietly. Unruly behavior of children in the waiting area will not be tolerated.
